GENERAL INFORMATION:

St Stephen's Catholic College pursues holistic and excellent education for all students. Within Catholic schools, students are challenged to grow spiritually, culturally, morally, intellectually and physically to achieve their personal best. The scholarship scheme in place at St Stephen's Catholic College provides opportunities for students to develop their potential within the context of a Catholic and Christian community.

Scholarships are available to students entering Year 7. Applications should be lodged by the specified date in the year prior to commencing secondary schooling. Each application will be considered by the Principal. **Short-listed applicants will be asked to attend an interview prior to a decision being made regarding the success of their application.**

Each scholarship has a value equivalent to the relevant student's tuition fees for a twelve month period. Therefore, school fee accounts for students awarded a scholarship will only include charges for levies, materials, bus costs and activities. The process of awarding a scholarship remains distinct from the granting of fee concessions in cases of financial need.

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

The successful applicants will demonstrate a desire to attend St Stephen's Catholic College and justify why they are worthy recipients of such an award. The criteria for awarding academic scholarships will include:

- Outstanding academic achievement justified by evidence in school reports, Naplan tests, state or national academic competitions
- A commitment to the values and culture of Catholic and Christian education
- Appropriate behaviour and consistent effort in school reports

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

1. A student applying for a scholarship must satisfy normal enrolment criteria.
2. Relevant documentary information to support the criteria must be attached to the application form, including the contact details of one referee who can validate the student's achievements.
3. Scholarship applications are submitted and received on the understanding that decisions regarding their success lie solely with the Principal and members of the College Leadership Team and College Board. Discussion of these decisions will not be entered into.
4. Short listed applicants are required to attend an interview.
5. Students awarded scholarships will display appropriate behaviour and attitude across all areas of curriculum.
6. Successful applicants will be offered a scholarship in only one of the three categories.
